

Former Harbor Art Guild member, Connie Newton, opens studio in Grayland



When a former HAG member becomes inactive in our group, we wonder what she may be up to. We know that Connie Immerzeel Newton is the coordinator for the Westport Art Festival, August 18 & 19, and that it's a huge undertaking, but her Facebook friends know that Connie has also just opened a new studio - **The Cat's Away**.

Located at **2172 St Rt 105**, across from The Local Bar in Grayland, the studio has flexible hours. Right now, she is trying an early week-night so that locals can pick up supplies during the week instead of driving to Olympia, waiting for the UPS guy, or for her store to be open on the weekends. **Store hours are Tuesday and Friday from 4pm to 7pm and Sat 10am to 4pm.** Plus class hours as scheduled.

Connie has art supplies for sale. Right now she has Pinata Alcohol Inks, felt for ink application, and Lindy's Stamp Gang two-toned embossing powders and shimmer sprays. Polymer clay will be next, and more things after that. She would LOVE to hear from anyone with suggestions of products they'd like to have available at her store.

When asked how this new endeavor is fulfilling her passion for art, Connie replied, "In two ways: first and foremost the studio is my 'she-shed' - the place I go to get away from the distractions of boyfriend, dogs and napping opportunities. I can just get away from the world, spread out and create!

"I had been trying to work in half a bedroom and it just was too cramped to be conducive to creativity, so here I can dial up the blues on the radio, shut out the world and just MAKE!

"Secondly, I've always enjoyed teaching, I love when a student has that "AHA!" moment and they realize they DO have creativity. I have so much fun laughing with students, meeting new friends, sharing tips and tricks - and I ALWAYS learn something from a student in a class, as well."

The Westport Art Festival takes up most of her time now so she

doesn't have classes scheduled until September 9, when she will be teaching mixed media techniques to decorate a paper mache wine bottle box/canister. She has plans for lots more classes, including beginners' polymer clay workshops, beginning alcohol ink class, all kinds of paper arts classes, and many project-oriented classes like making stamped dishtowels, sharpie marker scarves and more.

The Cat's Away Studio is a Gallery, Gift and Art Supply Store. It is a working artist's studio, and people are welcome to stop in any time, pull up a chair and see what she's doing. Her works are for sale, as well as her candle line - The Best Damn Candles On The Planet. She may begin consigning works by a few friends, but this will come later.
